Introduction

As far as I can ascertain there have been two previous, but partial, records compiled of the gravestones at St Bridget's Kirk, Dalgety Bay in Fife.

The first of these was a limited survey of selected stones carried out in the summer of 1896 by Erskine Beveridge of Dunfermline (who in addition to being one of the town's silk manufacturers was also a noted antiquarian) and his notes, in manuscript form, are held in the Central Reference Library in Dunfermline. The second was more detailed but only dealt with gravestones prior to 1855, when compulsory central registration of births, deaths and marriages came into force. This was conducted by J F and S Mitchell and published in 1972 in their book, "Monumental Inscriptions in West Fife prior to 1855"

This photographic survey was started out of personal interest and a desire to fully record all the stones and their inscriptions before they were finally worn away or damaged by teenagers who use the graveyard as a playground. The survey contains a record of all extant stones in the graveyard, whether inscribed or not, although stones without inscriptions have not been photographed. A map identifies the location of the stones.

The Erskine Beveridge survey of nearly one hundred years ago identified some stones which are now not legible or are missing. The text identifies these inscriptions.

The survey was carried out mainly during the summers of 1987 and 1988. It did not involve any probing or uncovering of stones and there may therefore be stones, and/or inscriptions which have not been located. This is also true in the case of partially sunk stones. Non-removal of turf which covered gravestones was a condition of the survey placed upon me by the Historic Buildings and Monuments Department of the Scottish Development Agency as this might have led to the risk of archaeological damage, and I was happy to abide by their decision.

Publication of the survey has been on a limited basis of 24 copies with the book being funded by Dalgety Parish Church, Shell and Exxon Chemicals. It has not been sold but has been donated to various research repositories where I hope it may be of benefit to future researchers and local historians.
